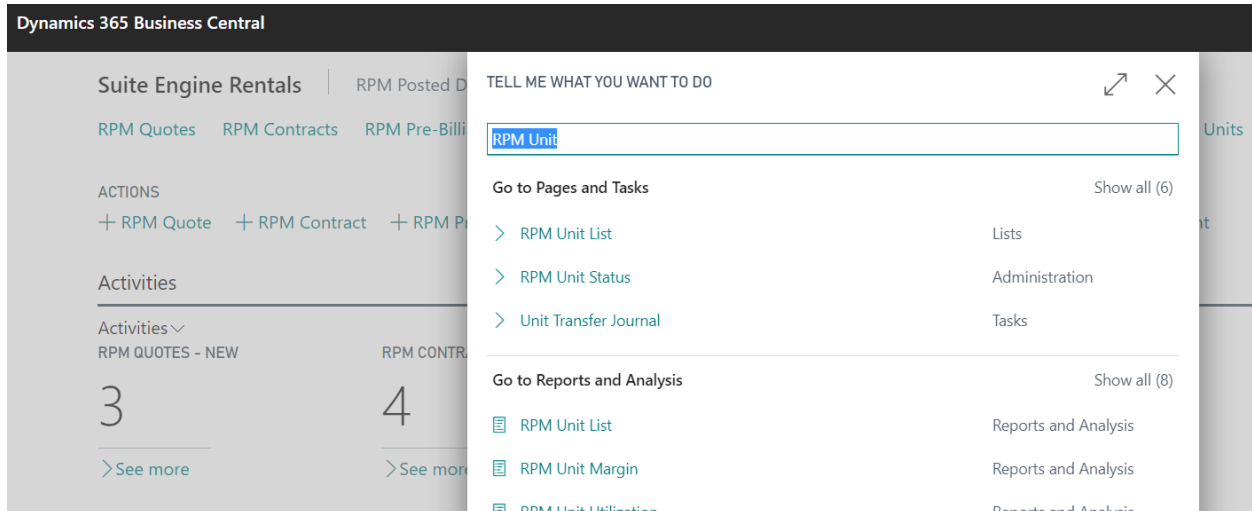
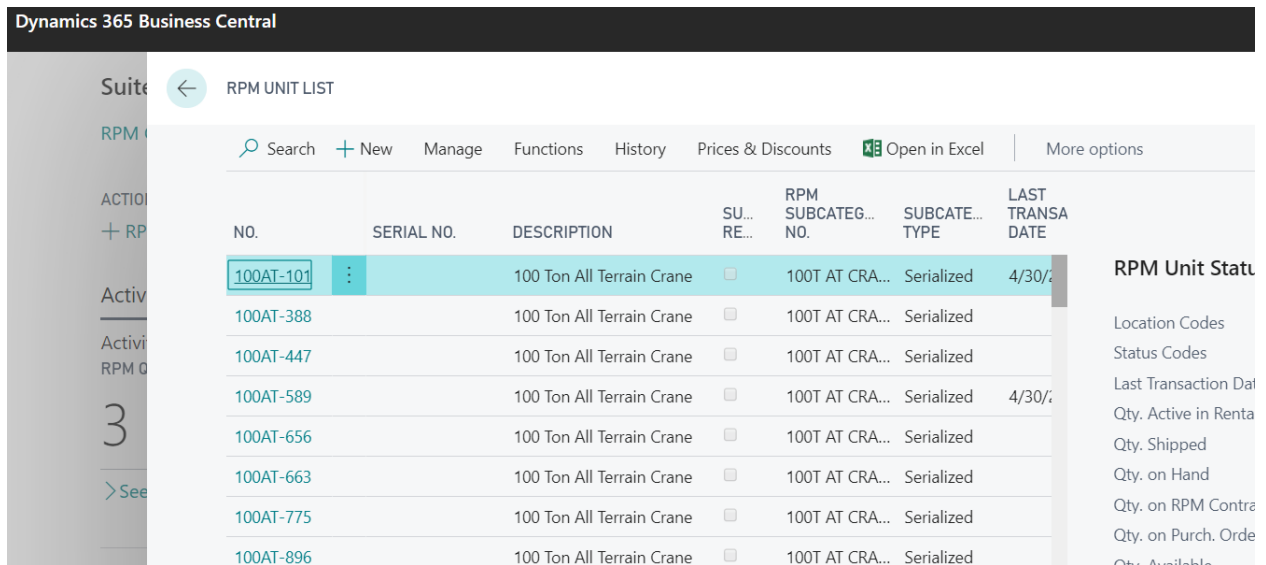


### Creating RPM Units:

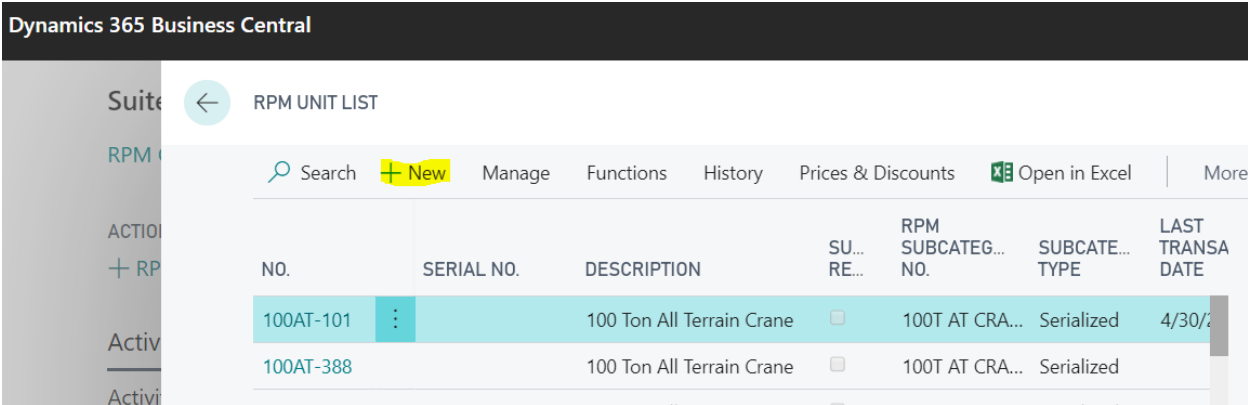
From the search window, type RPM Unit and choose the RPM Unit List option under Pages and Tasks:



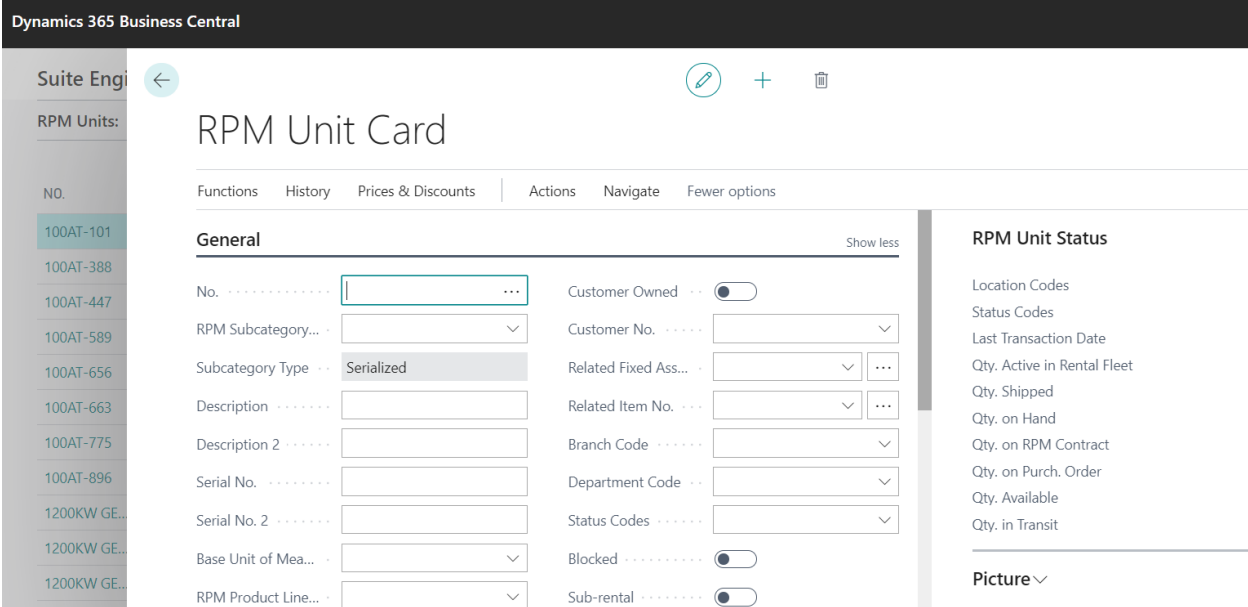
The PRM Unit List page will open:

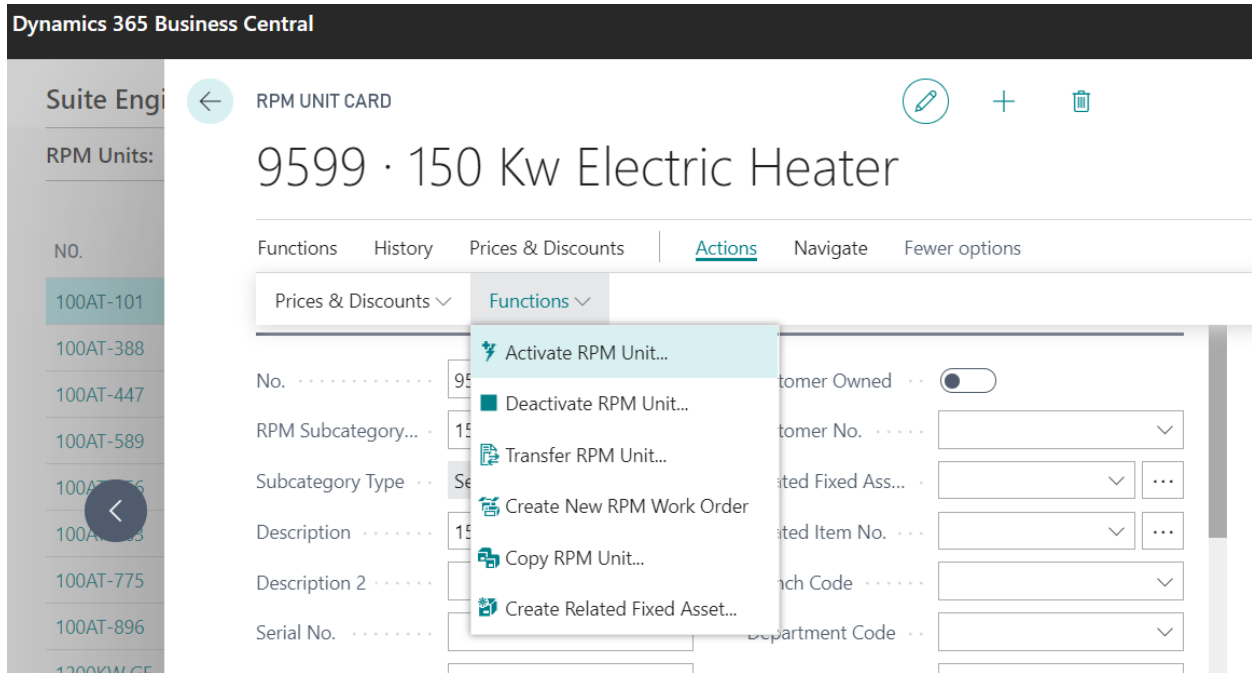

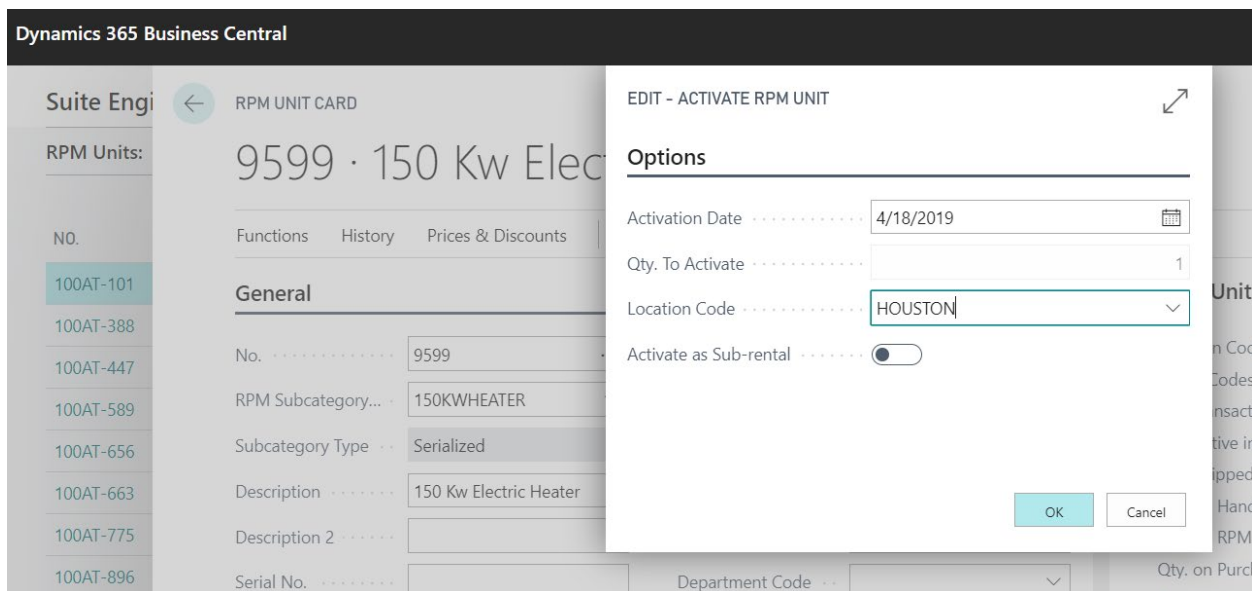
